Year 2 & Key Stage 2

This programme is designed to engage the class in a selection of activities to encourage and improve team work, problem solving and collaborative thinking. Typical challenges include:

Learn to trust your partner as you are guided around the woods to play 'hug a tree'.

Decorate a 'special wand' with natural finds.

Make a natural trail in the woods for others to follow to find their way to safety!

Create a natural 'Andy Goldsworthy' style piece of art using the natural woodland around you.

Build a shelter out of natural materials that is big enough for the team to fit inside, camouflaged and waterproof.

Go on a treasure hunt and work as a team to locate the 10 hidden boxes by following the clues and using the map.
